Mayor Manny Diaz

In February of this year, Mayor Diaz was recognized by the American Architectural Foundation (AAF), in association with the American Institute of Architects (AIA), with the foundation's AAF Keystone Award. The Keystone Award is presented annually by the AAF to an organization or an individual outside of the architectural profession, for their leadership in demonstrating the influence of architecture and design to improve lives and transform communities.

Mayor Diaz is only the third politician to be honored in the history of the Award. The AAF cited his commitment to, sustainable design and smart growth principles for Miami and for Miami 21, a revolutionary land-use and zoning master plan that incorporates transit-oriented development, increased open spaces and smart growth.

Guided by principles of conservancy and sustainability, Mayor Diaz has launched an expansive effort to "green" the city, erasing decades of environmental neglect. He is a signatory to the Mayors' Climate Protection agreement, pledging to reduce global warming emissions. Diaz has also promoted "Green Building" throughout the City and has committed to converting the city fleet to hybrid or other fuel-efficient vehicles by 2012. His efforts have earned him recognition by Vanity Fair Magazine as one of North America's leading environmental conscious mayors.

His other achievements include a billion-dollar Capital Improvement Plan to rebuild the city's infrastructure without levying new taxes, and grand improvements in education, law enforcement, crime and poverty reduction.

Mayor Diaz' visionary work has earned him international recognition. His numerous awards include, the Manhattan Institute's 2004 Urban Innovator of the Year and the 2006 National Public Leadership in the Arts Award by Americans for the Arts and the U.S. Conference of Mayors. In 2008, Mayor Diaz was named one of America's Best Leaders by the U.S. News Media Group in association with the Center for Public Leadership at Harvard Kennedy School.
